Every week Monday and Thursday	Every week Tuesday and Friday			Burnable Trash	Kitchen garbage Tissue and waste paper Fallen leaves and tree branched Diapers Others(Cigarette butt, waste textiles, etc.)	Please be sure to put this type of trash in the Mitoyo City-designated bags. Drain kitchen garbage well. If you own a garbage disposal unit, please make use of it as much as possible. Empty dirty disposable diapers before disposing them.
Every week Wednesday (Whole area)				Plastic containers and packaging	Plastic containers (Styrene foam, trays for food, plastic cups, plastic trays for eggs and instant noodles, etc.)	Be sure items are marked with the symbol to the left. Remove the contents of the containers. Please make sure to clean dirty items. Any items that are not possible to clean are treated as non-burnable. Shampoo pumps are considered "non-burnable" waste.
2nd Wednesday of every month		3rd Wednesday of every month		Paper containers and packaging	Paper containers (Paper boxes, paper bags, paper wrappings, etc)	Be sure items are marked with the symbol to the left. Wrappings without the mark shown to the left and any items that are not possible to clean are treated as "Burnable waste". Please remember to recycle newspapers, magazines, cardboard, milk/juice cartons, etc. as described below.
1st Monday of every month	1st Thursday of every month	1st Tuesday of every month	1st Friday of every month	Non-Burnable	Items including ceramics, glass, plastics not marked as プラ or PET, and other items(excluding rubber items, recyclables, toxic or metal waste, and other items listed below).	Items should be less than 50cm in length at their longest point. Cut long items such as hoses into lengths less than 50cm and bundle together. (If needed, use transparent or translucent garbage bags.)
2nd Monday of every month	2nd Thursday of every month	2nd Tuesday of every month	2nd Friday of every month	Cans	Food and beverage cans, spray cans etc.	Please be proactive in recycling aluminium cans at appropriate sites in your community. Remove the contents of the cans. Make a hole in spray cans before taking them out as waste. Be sure items are marked with the symbols to the left.
3rd Monday of every month	3rd Thursday of every month	3rd Tuesday of every month	3rd Friday of every month	Glass Containers	Beverage and food glass jars and bottles, etc. (Bottles used for items that can go in your mouth)	Remove the lids. Wash and dry the bottles. Cosmetics containers, oil bottles, heat-proof glass ware, dishes, and ceramics are treated as "non-burnables" waste.
4th Monday of every month	4th Thursday of every month	4th Tuesday of every month	4th Friday of every month	PET bottles	Plastic bottles, bottle containers for drinks, sweet cooking wine, sake, vinegar and soy sauce, etc.	Please be sure the bottles are marked with the PET symbol to the left. Remove the lids and labels and wash and dry the PET bottles. The lids and labels are categorized as "plastic container and packaging".
Twicw a year (to be announced)				Toxic waste Metal waste	Used batterines, fluorescent and incandescent light bulbs, mercurial thermometers, lighters. Metal products-pots, kettles, pans etc.	Collected at specified municipal collection sites twice a year. Separate different types of items. Do not break fluorescent/incandescent light bulbs. (In the case of broken bulbs, place them in a transparent or translucent garbage bag.) Be sure lighters are completely empty of lighter fluid.
